


Percentage of Adults Reporting
No Health Care Coverage






Adults Reporting No Health Care Coverage in Buncombe County

Percentage of Adults Ages 18 - 64 Reporting A Primary Care Home






Percentage of Buncombe Kindergarteners With Untreated Dental Disease





Children's Dental Sealant Program of Buncombe County



Percentage of Fifth Graders With Dental Sealants




Percentage of Buncombe Adults Who Have Lost Permanent Teeth Due to Decay or Gum Loss


Disparities in Dental Access

Percentage of Buncombe Adults Reporting 5 or More Years Since Visiting or Never Visiting a Dentist or Dental Clinic for Any Reason






Percentage of Buncombe Adults 18-64 Who Report Their Mental Health Was Not Good 8 or More Days in the Past Month





Percentage of Adults 18-64 Reporting No Days of Poor **Mental Health in the Past Month**








CURES Program Services by Calendar Year

Buncombe Disparity Ratios Death Rates 1999-2003




Buncombe Infant Mortality Rate per 1,000 Live Births







Buncombe Acolescent Pregnancy Rate, Ages 15-19







Percentage of Buncombe Adults Reporting - Fair or Poor **Health Status**






Percentage of Buncombe Residents who are Obese based on BMI


Percentage of Buncombe Adults Reporting 8 or More Days of Poor Mental Health in Past Month






Percentage of Buncombe Adults 18-64 Who are Overweight or Obese





Percentage of Buncombe County Adults Obese






Percentage of Buncombe Children Overweight - NC-NPASS


Weight Status (percentage) of K-5 Students in Buncombe County, 2004



Risk Factors by Race/Ethnicity: North Carolina Adults Ages 18 - 64, 2004


