- FY 2023 Affordable Housing Services Program Budget, Applications, & Recommendations
 - The committee recommended a split in funding for the two Emergency Repair requests from Asheville Area Habitat for Humanity and Mountain Housing Opportunities. The split would provide \$275K for AAHH and \$225K for MHO.
 - Comm. Edwards made a motion to recommend the following funding levels to the full County Board of Commissioners as a part of the budget process:
 - CDCA (Fairhaven Summit) New Construction \$1,000,000
 - LDG (Monticello Family) New Construction \$1,500,000
 - VOA (Laurel Wood) New Construction / Rehab \$800,000
 - MHO Emergency Repair \$225,000
 - AAHH Emergency Repair \$275,000
 - The motion passed unanimously.
