## IMMUNIZATIONS & TB TESTING

### IMMUNIZATIONS:

- For children and adults
- No appointment needed

### TRAVEL VACCINES:

- By appointment only
- Call 4-6 weeks before you travel

### TUBERCULOSIS (TB) TESTING:

- Clients are assessed for TB risk and symptoms to determine if testing is needed
- TB skin or blood tests (IGRAs) available to qualifying clients
- Monday, Tuesday, and Friday ONLY- No appointment needed.
- Clients receiving TB skin test need to return for results three days after test

## STD CLINIC

- Free, confidential testing for HIV, Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STDs), Hepatitis B & C
- HIV Pre- and Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP and PEP)
- Referral for treatment of HIV and Hepatitis
- Free condoms and risk-reduction education

## BREAST & CERVICAL CANCER CONTROL PROGRAM (BCCCP)

Serves women and transgender people between the ages of 40-64 who are un- or under-insured and meet income & eligibility requirements

Provides free:

- Pap smears & HPV testing
- Blood pressure, diabetes & cholesterol screenings
- Referral for treatment as needed

## FAMILY PLANNING

- Pregnancy testing
- Education & counseling on reproductive health and family planning
- Wide variety of birth control
- Emergency contraception (pill or IUD)
- Infertility counseling
- Pap smears & HPV testing
- Chest/breast exams & mammograms
- STD/HIV testing, treatment or referral

## COMMUNICABLE DISEASE CONTROL

- Public health nurses work with medical providers and other agencies on surveillance, investigation and control of communicable diseases
- Education to the community on how to prevent or stop the spread of disease
- Treatment of TB infection and active TB disease

## ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

### SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Permitting & inspection of new well and septic systems; restaurants, hotels, child care centers, tattoo parlors and swimming pools
- Childhood lead poisoning prevention and investigation

## WIC NUTRITION

The Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program helps provide low-income pregnant, breastfeeding, and postpartum women, infants and children up to the age of 5 with:

- Healthy foods
- Nutrition education
- Breastfeeding education and support
- Referrals to health and community services
