

Discussion of Funding Priorities

Funding will be allocated for the following purposes:

- Creating new classrooms to serve more children in early care and education settings;
- Implementing workforce development strategies to recruit and retain qualified teachers;
- Supporting strategies for scaling up effective programs; and
- Providing support services for children and families enrolled in early care and education programs.



Timeline and Funding Process

- May 7, 2019: Committee meeting begin scoring
- May 28, 2019: Committee member grant evaluations due
- June 4, 2019: Committee meeting discuss funding recommendations
- June 6, 2019: Placeholder for possible extra meeting
- June 7, 2019: Deadline for June 18 Board of Commissioners packet
- June 18, 2019: County Budget adoption = Target date for initial grant approvals
- July 1, 2019: FY2020 funding period begins
- July 1, 2019 June 30, 2020: Contracts, support, monitoring & evaluation
