Project Description

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Description of Project

The Buncombe County Veterans Treatment Court is seeking to reduce recidivism and improve long term success of participants by expanding services related to mental health and substance abuse, advancing case management and by improving judicial monitoring with increased technology. Participants will benefit from expanding services of experts providing multiple therapeutic disciplines. The Court will be improved by increased training for team members, increased screening tools and technology.

How many people will this project serve?*

This project will serve between 30-40 participants, depending on funding allocation.

Step 1: Identify within 3 months, licensed practitioners in numerous therapeutic disciplines and develop working contracts with those professionals in order to secure their services for Court participants.

Step 2: Enroll participants based on assessments and areas of need. Once enrolled, VTC team will evaluate the results over a period of one year of participation. The overall measure will be increased sobriety of participates and consistent engagement with services.

Step 3: Evaluate and utilize new judicial monitoring technology, including improved case management software, update screens with a focus on synthetics, and improved continual electronic alcohol monitoring. Explore proactive measures for heroin users. Provide the county with outcomes.

What evidence of success (i.e. evidence-based research, practice model, accreditation, industry standards, and/or other framework) are you using as a basis for your project design?

The project uses results based accounting (RBA) to track both the processes and outcomes of Buncombe County Veteran's Treatment Court. Specifically, the RBA evaluations assess whether the court is functioning according to the 10 Key Principles of VTC and evidence based principles of correctional programming, such as targeting high risk/high need clients. The outcomes tracked in the project include employment, stable and independent housing, reduced drug and alcohol use, and reduced recidivism.

A single site evaluation that includes staff survey data, client self-report data, probation data, and official arrest records that are collected by the evaluator (Dr. Jamie C. Vaske) and a multi-site evaluation that is funded by the National Institute of Justice that includes staff survey data, observational data of the staff meetings and court sessions, client interview data, treatment provider survey data, and official arrest and court records where BCVTC is being compared to seven other VTC's across the United States. Staff data for both projects include questions that examine team members; knowledge of court processes and perceptions of the court. Client self-report includes questions related to their substance use and treatment.

Currently, the Court is limited with spreadsheet tracking and hard copy paper notes for check in sheets and case notes. Files could be easier tracked and shared with team members across various disciplines with case management software which allows data sharing for accountability and tracking. Improved technology would also support the mission and goals of county evaluators and other stakeholders in the project.

The Mission of the Buncombe County Veteran's Treatment Court is to promote public safety through accountability and responsibility, and to assist and support veterans and their families through a coordinated effort among the court and community-based Veteran services, thereby leaving no veteran behind. The most recent strategic plan for the Court was developed in October, 2015. This projects advances the goals and missions of the VTC by modernizing and advancing specialty courts and the services that they can provide.

What expertise/accomplishments do you have that are relevant to the proposed project?*

The VTC team is comprised of members who are dedicated to the Mission and to supporting this unique and special population of citizens. Over the last two years, the Court has grown from 0 participants during the first year of the program's inception to 20 participants since June 2015. March is the first estimated graduation of participants, as they are required to complete a minimum of 12-18 months of successful engagement in the program. VTC has broadened their presence in the community with presentations to various organizations and some media attention, gaining support from the community at large for the population we serve. VTC team members have been invited to present and assist in the development of VTCs in other counties and judicial districts.

Last year, the request from the County was \$63,300. The Court received \$10,000. The allotment helped the court complete basic functions and has yielded positive results. However the court has to operate very conservatively. BCVTC is fast approaching capacity the cost of basic function will rise. After a year in operation we have identified several service issues in housing, treatment and the sophistication of drug use by participants. By supporting advanced technology, training of staff and modernizing how specialty courts function the court can achieve optimal outcomes. Through BCVTC court innovation and knowledge we gain can be shared with other specialty courts. The data could be used to support Buncombe County goals of safer communities, reducing recidivism, lowering jail time and increasing the opportunity of citizens that struggle with addiction and mental health challenges.
