BIRTH CONTROL METHODS

- ✓ Birth control pills
- ✓ Condoms
- ✓ Contraceptive shot (Depo Provera)
- ✓ Contraceptive vaginal ring (Nuva Ring)
- ✓ IUD (Mirena, ParaGard)
- ✓ Contraceptive implant (Implanon)
- ✓ Diaphragm with spermicide jelly
- ✓ Natural Family Planning counseling
- ✓ Permanent birth control

Same day birth control without an exam.

SERVICES FOR WOMEN

- Answers to your questions
- Birth control
- Condoms
- Emergency contraception (pill or IUD)
- Pregnancy testing
- Cervical cancer tests (Pap smear, HPV test)
- Infertility counseling
- Physical exam, including breast exam
- STD testing & treatment HIV testing and referral.

- Condoms
- Vasectomies (referrals)
Permanent birth control for men
- Men's health exams
- STD testing & treatment HIV testing and referral.

SERVICES FOR EVERYONE

Counseling and referrals for pregnancy options.

All services are **free or low cost**.

Our fees are based on your income, and may be as low as zero.

Parent consent is not required & services are confidential.

No one is turned away because they cannot afford to pay.

We accept Medicaid and most private insurance.
