The Western North Carolina Regional Air Quality Agency Board of Directors met on Monday, November 14, 2011, at the boardroom of the Western North Carolina Regional Air Quality Agency, located at 49 Mt. Carmel Road, Asheville, NC.

Mr. Lovin called the meeting of the Western North Carolina Regional Air Quality Agency Board of Directors to order on November 14, 2011, at approximately 3:57 p.m.

The order of business was as follows:

I. PUBLIC COMMENT PROTOCOL ANNOUNCEMENT:

Mr. Lovin started the meeting by reading the announcement about the public comment protocol.

II. APPROVAL OF AGENDA:

There were no other changes to the Agenda, and Mr. Kirk made a motion for approval. Dr. Kahl seconded the motion, and it was approved 4-0.

III. CONSENT AGENDA:

<u>Approval of minutes from the September 12, 2011 Board Meeting:</u> Mr. Kirk made a motion to approve the minutes with no changes, and Mr. Koon seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.

IV. UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

A. <u>Update on Kearfott:</u> Mr. Brigman met with officials from Kearfott to discuss the fine amount. He offered them a reduction of 25%, which they decided to accept rather than appeal to the Board. We are waiting on payment

V. <u>DIRECTOR'S REPORT:</u>

- A. <u>CTS Demo Report:</u> Mr. Frue updated the Board on the demolition of the old CTS plant in Arden. All parties involved with the property met and decided to tear down the building rather than try to repair it. The Agency is monitoring the asbestos removal as well as the demolition. The county is also doing air monitoring around the perimeter of the site.
- **B.** Quarterly Report -3^{rd} Quarter 2011: There were no questions about the Quarterly Report. The county had a good ozone season this year.

Mr. Brigman informed the Board the Agency is still working with the city about collecting permit fees. The county started collecting fees for the Agency in October.

Mr. Koon ask how we would know that the recycled shingles did not contain asbestos, and Mr. Brigman informed him that each batch would be tested. There were no further questions regarding the permit modifications, and Mr. Koon made a motion to approve the permits. Mr. Kirk seconded the motion, and it was approved 4-0.

VI. NEW BUSINESS:

- **A.** Regulatory Changes: The EPA has issued revised standards for SO₂ and NO₂. The state also has to change their regulations to match the EPA. We are adopting these changes by reference. Mr. Koon moved to approve the changes, and Dr. Kahl seconded the motion. It was approved 4-0.
- **B.** <u>Legal Council Report Mr. Frue:</u> Mr. Frue stated he had nothing new to report. The Pitrolo lawsuit is still waiting for a ruling.

VII. OTHER BUSINESS:

- **A.** Advisory Committee Report Dean Kahl: The committee met on September 19th and worked on several items, including adding pollen information to the website. This is ready to go as soon as the Agency can get it on the website. They will work on the guidelines for the *Standing Ovation* Awards and the *Pat on the Back* Awards at the next meeting. Mr. Brigman and Ms. Featherstone met with the Buncombe County Department of Health about the air quality flag program and will have recommendations at the next meeting also. The committee is scheduled to meet again on November 21, 2011.
- **B.** <u>Calendar:</u> Mr. Lovin informed the Board that November 12, 2012 is a holiday so the meeting date would need to be changed. The date will be changed to the 13th if that is agreeable with everyone. The next meeting for the Board will be January 9, 2012 at 4:00 p.m.
