RESOLUTION AWARDING A SERVICE FIREARM TO A RETIRING DEPUTY OF THE BUNCOMBE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT

- WHEREAS, in accordance with North Carolina General Statute Section 20-187.2, the local body of a law enforcement agency shall award a retiring deputy his or her badge and may, in its discretion, award the deputy's service firearm; and
- WHEREAS, the County of Buncombe provides the service firearm of a deputy who retires through the North Carolina Local Government Retirement System with ten (10) or more years of service to Buncombe County as a deputy sheriff or who retires due to medical disability; and
- WHEREAS, John Ogle has retired after rendering honorable and invaluable service to the County of Buncombe and its citizens from May 5, 1995 through November 1, 2008 as a full time sworn deputy; and
- WHEREAS, the Buncombe County Commissioners and the Buncombe County Sheriff wish to honor Mr. Ogle for his service to the County as a law enforcement officer by awarding him his badge and the service firearm that he carried at the time of his retirement, a Glock Model 17, serial number EST 832; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

That John Ogle's badge and a Glock Model 17, Serial No. EST 832 are declared surplus and upon securing a permit as required by N.C.G.S. §14-402 et al., that the County Manager or her designee is authorized to award his badge and transfer said firearm to Chris Gant in accordance with the provisions of N.C.G.S. § 20-187.2.
