UNC-ASHEVILLE BULLDOG DAY NOVEMBER 13, 2011

WHEREAS, drawing students from all across the nation, the University of North Carolina at Asheville is well known for its dedication to academics and athletics and has a wonderful athletic program and a new wellness center and arena on campus; and

WHEREAS, our community is very proud of the UNC- Asheville men's basketball team who were the 2011 Big South Tournament Champions and 2nd Round of NCAA Basketball Championship Playoffs; and

WHEREAS, the UNC-Asheville Bulldogs will host the UNC-Chapel Hill Tarheels, one of the top ranked college basketball teams in the nation, on November 13 on the Bulldog's home court at UNC-Asheville; and

WHEREAS, the Asheville City Council and Buncombe County Commissioners wish to honor the UNC-Asheville Bulldogs as they start their athletic season by declaring a day in their honor.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED BY the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe and by the Mayor for the City of Asheville as follows:

1. That November 13, 2011 be proclaimed:
