An advisory referendum on the question of whether to levy a One-Quarter Cent (1/4¢) County Sales and Use Tax was held on November 8, 2011 by authority of Article 46 of Chapter 105 of the North Carolina General Statutes and in accordance with N.C.G.S. §163-287, and the Buncombe County Board of Elections has certified that a majority of those voting in said referendum voted in favor of the levy of the tax. The Buncombe County Board of Commissioners will consider a resolution approving the levy of a local sales and use tax at the rate of one-quarter percent (0.25%) in addition to all other State and local sales and use taxes on Tuesday, December 6, 2011 at 4:30 in the Commissioners' Chambers located at 30 Valley Street in Asheville, North Carolina.
