Adult Protective Services

Community Alternative Program (CAP)

 CAP is a Medicaid program that allows adults 18 years or older to remain in their home instead of being placed in a nursing home.

In-home Aide Services

 Help given to elderly or disabled persons so that they can stay in their home safely for as long as possible.

Services For The Blind

 Provides help to blind and/or visually impaired persons with low income who do not have Medicaid or other health insurance.

Representative Payee Services

 Provides help with Social Security or SSI benefits for individuals who are unable to manage their resources independently and who have no one else to serve as payee.

Guardianship Services

 Guardianship is a legal relationship in which DSS is authorized by the clerk of court to be a guardian (caretaker) for individuals whom the court has decided can no longer manage their affairs.
