You could be a drug dealer and not even know it.

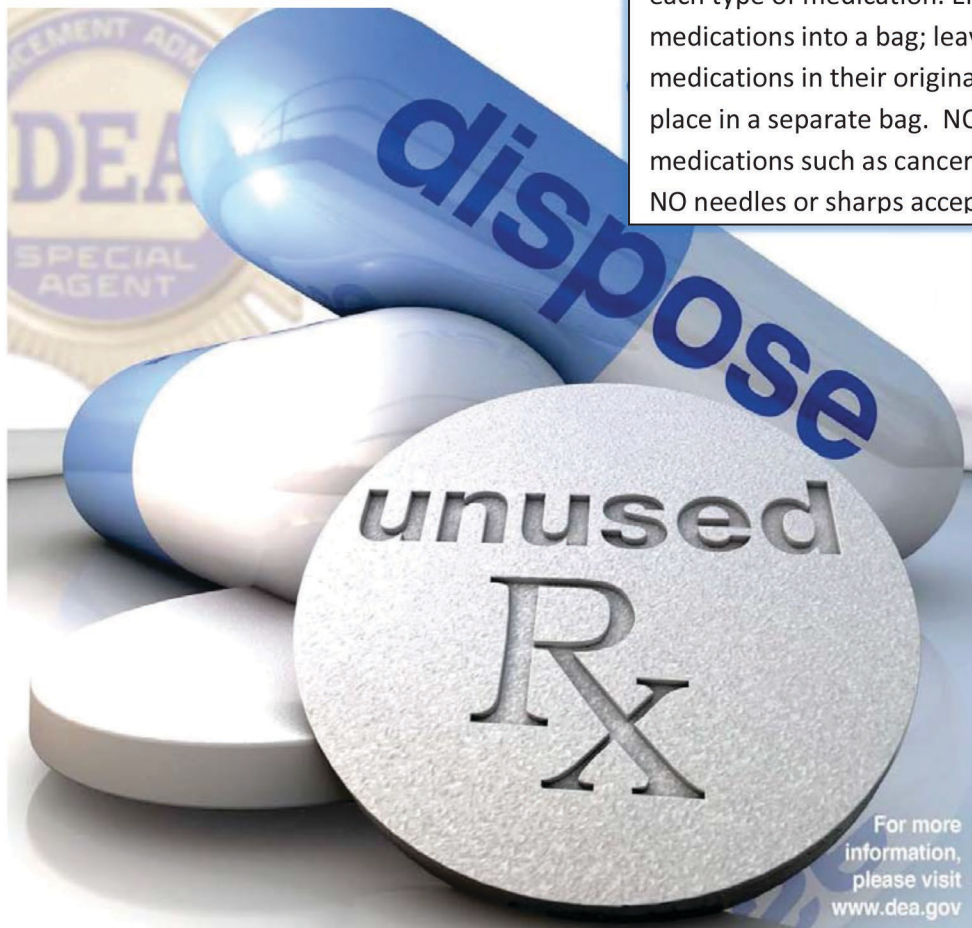
Saturday April 30th from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS:

Remove identification from all medications. Separate pill, liquids and inhalers. Use a different disposable paper or plastic bag for each type of medication. Empty dry pill medications into a bag; leave liquid medications in their original container and place in a separate bag. NO Radioactive medications such as cancer medications. NO needles or sharps accepted.
