I certify the above information to be correct and accurate. I am the owner or authorized legal representative for the property described above and hereby grant permission for Buncombe County Environmental Services to enter the property to perform inspection. I understand that if any information provided in this application is changed or found to be false it may result in suspension or revocation of any permits issued. I understand that it is my responsibility as the owner/applicant to identify and comply with all applicable ordinances, laws, and rules that may affect development of this property.

- A representative from the Buncombe County Department of Health will issue a permit to drill your well in an area that meets all NC well construction standards
- Inspections will be conducted by the Department of Health during the drilling process
- After power is connected to the well the Department of Health will sample the well for the following items:
 - Total & fecal coliform bacteria, silver, alkalinity, arsenic, barium, calcium, cadmium, chloride, chromium, copper, fluoride, iron, hardness, mercury, magnesium, manganese, sodium, nitrite, nitrate, lead, pH, selenium, sulfate and zinc
- Follow the guidelines below to help protect and maintain your well:
 - Keep any potential sources of contamination away from the well
 - Slope well area so surface runoff drains away
 - Do not mix or handle pesticides, fertilizers, herbicides, degreasers, or fuels near a well
 - Periodically visually inspect well and have well sampled
- Always hire a certified well contractor for any new well construction, repairs, or abandonment

Upon final inspection your well will meet the North Carolina well construction standard requirements in accordance with the North Carolina Administration Code Title 15A subchapter 2C. Future performance of your well with respect to yield, aesthetic quality, or contamination is not guaranteed by Buncombe County.
