2013 Resource Conservation Workshop

Dates: June 23 - June 28, 2013 Place: NC State University

Subjects to be Covered:

- Soil Characteristics and Soil Conservation
- Wildlife & Fisheries Management
- Forest Management
- Nonagricultural Uses for Soils
- Water Quality & Watershed Management

Scholarship Opportunity:

- Grady Lane Award: \$100 cash and \$500 college scholarship* the Grady Lane award is the grand prize of the RCW. Each counselor selects a student who is then interviewed by a panel and a winner is selected. Selected criteria include academic scores, counselor evaluations, financial need, attitude and interview results.
- District Employee's Association Award: *\$1,000 college scholarship** this award is sponsored by the DEA. This award may be given in increments of two \$500 scholarships.
- Academic scores from the challenge exam: five other RCW awards are presented using academic scores from the challenge exam (including the tiebreaker question):
 - 1st Place \$100 cash and \$500 college scholarship*
 - 2nd Place \$100 cash and \$275 college scholarship*
 - 3rd Place \$100 cash



- 4th Place \$75 cash
- 5th Place \$50 cash

Housing:

Students will be housed in the Lee Residence Hall (air conditioned) on NCSU campus. Adult counselors will be provided based on one counselor for every 7-8 students.

Eligibility:

A student who has demonstrated an interest in natural resource conservation is eligible to attend. High School graduates are not eligible to attend. Priority should be given to **sophomores, juniors** and **seniors**. Students may participate only one time in this workshop.

Costs

The cost of the workshop will be paid by the Buncombe County Soil & Water Conservation District. This includes room, linens, instructional supplies, insurance and planned meal functions. A refrigerator and microwave are provided in most rooms.

In addition, the district will provide each student with enough money to cover the cost of food other than organized meals (\$100 for 11 meals) and will also provide transportation from an area drop off point to Raleigh. A van will be provided by the Area 1 Soil & Water Conservation District to take students to RCW and bring them back to the central location at the end of the week. The overall package is worth \$500.00 at no cost to the students.
