

**ORDINANCE NO.**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING  
CHAPTER 78, ARTICLE VI BUNCOMBE COUNTY ZONING ORDINANCE  
OF THE BUNCOMBE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, a request has been received to amend the official zoning maps of the Buncombe County Zoning Ordinance for the parcels identified as tax lot PIN #9655.14-43-6727, located at 105 Mills Gap Road, and tax lot PIN #9655.14-43-6952, located at 107 Mills Gap Road as shown on the attached Exhibit "A", from R-2 residential to EMP employment.

WHEREAS, the provisions set forth in Division 8 of Article VI of the Buncombe County Code of Ordinances have been met in order to amend the Buncombe County Zoning Ordinance.

WHEREAS, the Planning Board has met to consider this request to rezone the above parcels from R-2 residential to EMP employment and has recommended in a vote of 5-2 on September 15, 2008 that the request be approved.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Buncombe County Zoning Ordinance the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe does hereby propose to amend said ordinance as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That this action is consistent with the Buncombe County Land Use Plan, reasonable, and in the public interest as the property is located in an area suitable for EMP development.
2. That the Board of Commissioners is of the opinion that it is in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the County to approve this request and hereby approves this request for map amendment.
3. That this ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption.
