**Narrative summary of grant related activities**

The INA program concluded with a process development for future events and a reflection session. We have taken feedback to incorporate for next projects. Through our ongoing voucher and outreach programming, we served 50 youth through collaboration with Christine Avery Learning center and about 45 adults. We conducted a staff refresher training on behavior management and self care. Additionally, we did a parent workshop to offer insight in how to manage disruptive behaviors. These programs included behavioral observations and consultations, staff and parent workshops We also awarded vouchers for 15 people during quarter three. We have recently appointed our new position of Community Outreach and Brand Ambassador. This person is responsible for engaging the community, presenting at conferences, and networking at events. She works approximately 5 hours a week.
