Item One –

The polls were opened at 6:30 a.m. The Buncombe County Board of Elections (BOE) meeting was called to order at 7:30 a.m. on Election Day at 77 McDowell Street, Asheville, NC 28801.

Item Two –

At 10:00 a.m. Staff Member John Noce presented the list of approved absentee applications for signing. The list will be sent to the State Board of Elections.

Item Three -

At 2:00 p.m. the board reviewed the following absentee applications: 5 military, 50 Overseas, 267 Civilian and 663 one stops. The four member bipartisan team duplicated emailed ballots and those that would not scan. The team affirmed that all marks and calls were to their satisfaction. Vice Chair Smith motioned to approve the military, overseas and civilian applications. Member Quinn seconded with the motion passing. Member

Quinn motioned to approve the 663 one-stop applications. Vice Chair Smith seconded with the motion passing.

Item Four -

Staff Member Jennifer Sparks presented the absentee application of Jason Williams King. Mr. King is listed as a felon in North Carolina who has not had his rights restored. The Board had denied his application for registration, and challenges his ballot. The appropriate document was completed.

Item Five -

Ms. Sparks presented the zero documentation for the scanner used for today's absentee ballots, along with the summary of numbers of applications/ballots scanned.

The polls were closed at 7:30 p.m. The board convened to the Coxe Avenue building at approximately 8:00 a.m. and adjourned at 10:30 p.m.
