

STORMWATER REVIEW OF SITE PLAN REVIEW (SPR) PERMITS

When applying for a Site Plan Review (SPR) permit from the Planning Department for an individual structure, staff will review the site plan for compliance with the development's previously approved Stormwater Permit.

Information must be included on the site plan showing how stormwater runoff from the individual structure will tie into the stormwater system on the site. Typically that level of detail is not included in the stormwater plan, and is reviewed at the SPR stage. **Below are 3 examples of site plans for an SPR permit showing stormwater information:**
