 - ✓ Adjusted in the wake of Helene
- ✓ Completed fieldwork for one special project
 - Report to be presented at next Audit Committee meeting
- ✓ FY 2025 Audit Plan
 - ✓ Procurement Card Audit



What did Helene Look Like?

- ✓ Re-assigned to manage County Distribution Warehouses to help distribute supplies
 - ✓ Independence Considerations unable to audit warehousing process
- ✓ Internal Audit Employee Retirement & Hiring Freeze
- ✓ Re-evaluation of Risk by IA & Buncombe County Management



Next Steps – FY 2025

- ✓ Hire open positions once hiring freeze ends
- ✓ Continue to develop process documentation
- ✓ Begin audit work approved by Audit Committee
- ✓ Complete Risk Assessment for FY 2026 Audit Plan
- ✓ Presentation at Industry Conference
