


Broadband Project Updates



GREAT – Skyrunner


- Contract: finalized (April 2022) and first grant installment paid (March 2024)
- Areas Impacted: Leicester and Fairview
- Awarded locations: 493
- Construction period: ends November 2025
- Status Updates (as of 12/31/24):
 - Project Design: 25%-75% complete
 - Construction: 25%-75% complete
 - Infrastructure damage from Helene: repairs complete






GREAT – Frontier

- Contract: finalized (May 2023) and first grant installment paid (June 2024)
- Area Impacted: North Buncombe
- Awarded locations: 964
- Construction period: scheduled to end April 2025 – requested extension due to Helene
- Status updates (as of 12/31/24)
 - Project Design: 100% complete
 - Construction: Less than 25% of complete




CAB - BellSouth (AT&T)

- Contract: finalized (July 2024) and County Match Requirement removed by General Assembly (November 2024)
- Areas Impacted: Broad River,
 Upper Hominy, and Fairview
- Awarded Locations: 967
- Status update:
 - Construction period ends
 10/31/2026 on track to meet this deadline





Buncombe NCDIT Profile as of Sept. 2024



- Most recent NCDIT profile is missing the CAB project
- Significant progress toward broadband expansion
- 2,079 remaining unserved or underserved locations
 - Estimated 15,000 unserved or underserved locations

Cell Phone Service post-Helene

Updates

- As of October 20th, cell phone service recovery was over 98%, or within the range of normal operations
 - 311/348 cell sites were back online across all carriers
 - At this time, the FCC (Federal Communications Commission) stopped publishing reports
 - Ongoing reporting: systemic issues have previously been flagged from public safety, inspectors, social workers, etc.

Buncombe Tower Sites

- BC IT team is working with carriers to lease space for equipment at two sites: Broad River and Landfill
- Buncombe County continues to make tower sites (~15) available for lease for providers (AT&T, Verizon, etc.) to lease for their equipment

CAB and GREAT Grants

Completed construction anticipated in 2025 and 2026

Recent Award – NTIA (National Telecommunications and Information Administration) Digital Equity Award for "WNC Connecting All Communities" Project

- Notice received January 2025
- Land of Sky lead applicant
- Buncombe County Libraries is a participating partner
- Outcomes: BC Libraries will purchase a <u>mobile library unit</u> and provide digital equity access in rural and low- to moderate-income communities
- More details to come, NTIA and LOS are evaluating impact of recent Executive Orders

Upcoming Broadband Opportunities

Stop Gap Grant Program

- Guidance is TBD
- Program leaning towards small projects (e.g., less than 25 houses)
- Potential provider/county/resident process to identify areas and apply for grant funding for line extensions

CAB 2.0

- State-run process
- Buncombe has not yet received proposals
- Scope of Work for Buncombe County anticipated mid-February

Broadband Expansion Background

North Carolina <u>does not currently allow</u> local government to treat broadband as a public utility. (NC General Statute § 62-2. Public Utilities Act, Declaration of Policy)

Recognizing that adequate broadband service is essential to its citizens and economy, since 2016 Buncombe County has taken a more active role to entice competition and improve service offerings.

Broadband expansion is essential for:

- Public Safety
- Economic Development
- Healthcare/Telehealth
- Digital Inclusion/Reducing the Homework Gap



Broadband Expansion Timeline

- 2016, WestNGN (West Next Generation Network) launches to stimulate the deployment of broadband networks in WNC
 - Land of Sky Regional Council
- 2019, Buncombe County Community Survey and Profile
 - 12% of homes considered unserved by any internet provider (15,000 parcels estimated)
- 2020, Buncombe County Government created the Buncombe Broadband Workgroup to respond to growing need for broadband access to served and underserved households

Broadband Expansion Timeline

- 2021, American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), in North Carolina, Gov.
 Cooper and the General Assembly dedicated more than \$1 billion for digital equity, including \$971 million for infrastructure
- Buncombe County Projects:
 - GREAT, Growing Rural Economies with Access to Technology Grant: two projects awarded in Buncombe
 - \$5.1 million total award from State
 - \$479,000 County Match
 - CAB, Completing Access to Broadband: one project awarded, CAB 2.0
 Scope of Work is pending
 - \$7.2 million total award from State
 - \$0 County Match (as of November 2024)
