RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION TO ABANDON SR 2157 LOVIN ROAD

WHEREAS, the Board of Transportation has received an Abandonment Petition from the owner on SR 2157, Lovin Road, requesting that the State of North Carolina abandon the entire road consisting of 0.35 miles that serves only their property;

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §136-63, a board of county commissioners of any county may, on its own motion or on petition of a group of citizens, request the Board of Transportation to change or abandon any road in the secondary system when the best interest of the people of the county will be served thereby;

WHEREAS, if this Board concurs with the Abandonment Petition, the Board of Transportation will make inquiry into the proposed change or abandonment, and if in its opinion the public interest demands it, shall make such change or abandonment; and

WHEREAS, this Board is of the opinion that it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the County to concur with this Abandonment Petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners for the County of Buncombe as follows:

1. That pursuant to N.C. Gen. Stat. §136-63 the Board of Transportation is hereby requested to abandon SR 2157, Lovin Road, consisting of 0.35 miles, in its entirety.
2. That this Resolution shall be effective upon its adoption.
