
2030 Strategic Plan

- Alignment with the County's comprehensive plan
- Strategic plans and departmental business plans to be completed by Nov. 2024
- If a goal is in the plan, it must be measurable, and the data must be reported by adoption date
- Increase alignment with budget
- Strategic Plan stands alone
 - Has its own objectives and goals
 - No forced alignment to business plans

Focus Area 6 Operational/Foundational

SMART Goals


Ensure time between musical acts are reduced to no longer than 10 minutes by 2030

- Demographic information being collected.



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Proposed 2030 Strategic Objectives Education

- Enhance Early Learning
 - Providing Pre-K support
- Strengthen Pathways to Adulthood
 - Enhance opportunities for career pathing
- Support Adult Learning
 - Adult literacy and life-long learning
- Holistically Improve Equity in Education
 - Improve outcomes across demographic groups



Proposed 2030 Strategic Objectives Health and Public Safety

- Increase Coordination and Resilience of Public Health and Safety Services
 - Focus is on faster LEO and ES response times, reduction in behavioral health-related crimes, increased awareness of available services
- Increase Holistic Prevention Efforts to Create a Safer Community
 - Focus on foster care reduction, increase the number of BIPOC service providers, enhanced dispatch capabilities, increased county services and community partners
- Increase Equitable Access to Physical, Mental, and Behavioral Health and Safety Resources
 - Increased access to public health services, decreased substance use-related deaths, reduced demand for 911 services, increase BIPOC service providers in the community
- Enhance the County's Commitment to Uplifting Person-Centered Options to Support Wellbeing
 - Decreasing rates of suicide and substance use-related deaths
- Enhance Health and Public Safety Programs' Sustainability through Increased Support for Frontline Workers' Health and Wellbeing
 - Focus on employee retention and morale and mitigating employee trauma

Proposed 2030 Strategic Objectives Energy & Environment

- Preserve the Agriculture Heritage of Buncombe County
 - Farmland preservation succession
- Prioritize the Protection of Natural Resources
 - Conservation easements and investing in code enforcement and composting facilities
- Reduce Greenhouse Gas Emissions
 - Fleet electrification, waste diversion and home weatherization programs
- Increase Hazard Mitigation and Disaster Preparedness to Support a Climate Resilient Community
 - Equitable Hazard Mitigation Plan and monitoring investments



Proposed 2030 Strategic Objectives Economic Development

- Increase Opportunities and Support for Local Workforce
 - Focused on incentive projects that include benefits, skills training, and employment programs
- Increase Business Opportunities with Buncombe County
 - The County will focus on increasing Request For Proposals (RFPs) and contracts with minority owned business
- Increase Access to Quality Internet
 - Focus will be on underserved areas of the County
- Increase Economic Opportunity in Buncombe County
 - Focus is on increasing the # of small businesses, wage rates, and minority home ownership

Proposed Objectives Growth and Development

- Enhance transportation opportunities through partnerships, emphasizing the needs of underserved and BIPOC communities
 - Providing greater access to mass transportation geographically and demographically
- Incentivize a diversity of housing as a foundation for affordable, healthy, and thriving communities, particularly for the most vulnerable residents
 - Addressing housing cost burden issues
- Maximize the use of land, guiding development to targeted growth areas that lead to resilient communities
 - Responsible and effective development strategies
