Register

- Fill out a registration form and send it in by Oct 11.
- Already registered? Skip to step 2.
- Please register early. If you do miss the deadline you can register and vote at any early voting location Oct 17 - Nov 2.

Look Up Your Voter Information

- Confirm your personal information, such as your address and party affiliation.
- Review your sample ballot.

Have Your ID With You

- All voters must now show a photo ID to vote in North Carolina. Any registered voter can get a **free photo ID** from the County Board of Elections.
- Any NC resident can also get a free non-driver's ID card from the NCDMV.

Absentee By-Mail

- Anyone can vote absentee by-mail.
- Fill out a request form and return it by Oct. 29 or visit our online portal at [votebymail.ncsbe.gov](https://www.votebymail.ncsbe.gov).
- Get your ballot in the mail. Mail it back or drop it off in person at our office or any early voting location.

Early Voting

- Oct. 17 - Nov. 2
- Vote at any of the early voting locations.
- Use the wait map on our website to see how many voters are in line.

Election Day

- November 5
- Polls are open from 6:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m.
- Find your assigned voting location under Voter Information on our website, call us or visit our office.
